There is a proposal for a battery energy storage site in Coleby

## What size is it?

35 hectares, which is 86.5 acres - 5 acres is almost the size of 4 football pitches

## How does battery energy storage work?

There are lithium-ion batteries, situated in containers that are similar to those used for shipping/lorries. There is also electrical infrastructure to connect these to the pylons, a sub-station, so that high voltage electricity can be taken and added back to the Grid.
